The Gemini's appeal should be further broadened with the introduction of a ride and handling suspension option. This has been designed to appeal to buyers who are looking for a more sports orientated suspension system.

This compact Japanese car is fully equipped with power assisted brake system - front discs; push button radio with rear speaker; electric clock; loop pile carpet throughout and fully reclining bucket seats with integral head restraints. Other standard features include armrests - front and rear; single key locking system and steering column control stalks for windscreen washers/wipers and turn signals, headlight dimmer and flasher.

The standard 1600 OHC engine combines excellent performance characteristics with proven reliability. The tri-matic automatic transmission with 'T' bar floorshift is available as an option as is fully integrated air conditioning which cools, heats, demists and de-humidifies.

The fashion pack which has proved to be such a great success with the 'Coupe' has now been extended to the sedan. The fashion pack option includes sporty wheel covers plus the handsome

custom plaid cloth trim inserts in the door panels and the seats.

Safety features include power assisted flow-through ventilation and 3-speed heater/demister; back-up lamps, inertia real front seat belts; split circuit braking system; hazard warning flasher; padded dashboard; toughened windshield and safety glass windows and anti-burst doorlocks.
